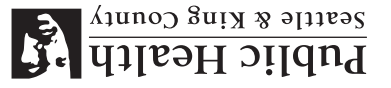

What do you need ?

Arrive 30 minutes early to complete the registration form. There is no admittance after classes begin. You must be able to read the book and test, and to write out your registration form. If there are reasons you may need help, call ahead to make arrangements. Photo ID is required. Bring \$10.00 cash to pay for your Food Handlers card. Card fee will be collected when you arrive. If you are renewing for a 3 year card, bring in your old card (or a copy) that expired less than 30 days ago, or will expire within the next 60 days. For a 5 year card, bring in proof (certificate or card) that you have completed an approved food safety training class within the last 2 years, as well as your old food handlers card that expired less than 30 days ago, or will expire within the next 60 days.
